COMPETITIONS

1. **ASSOCIATION GOLD and SILVER MEDALS:**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 400 and 600 metres.
The Gold Medal is open only to previous winners of the Scottish Championships, Grand Aggregate, Caledonian Shield or an Association Silver Medal won in SR(b)TR competition. All other competitors shoot for the Silver Medal.
2. **THE SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIP**
1st Stage:
Concurrent with competitions 3, 4 and 5
2nd Stage: Monday
Open to 36 competitors taking the highest places in the 1st Stage. 2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards. The score in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score in the Royal Faculty of Procurators Competition.
Final Stage: Monday
Open to 20 competitors (including "F" Class depending on number of entries) taking the highest places in the 2nd stage, 2 sighters and 15 count at 1000 yards. The places of all competitors in the Final Stage will be decided by the aggregate of their scores in the 2nd and Final Stages. The score from the first 10 rounds in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score in the City of Glasgow Competition.
3. **STOCK EXCHANGE**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 400 metres.
4. **BANNOCKBURN**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 500 metres.
5. **PRESIDENTS**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 600 metres.
6. **ROYAL FACULTY OF PROCURATORS IN GLASGOW**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards.
7. **CITY OF GLASGOW**
2 sighters and 10 to count at 1000 yards.
8. **SATURDAY AGGREGATE**
The aggregate of competitions 1 and 3.

9. **SUNDAY AND MONDAY AGGREGATE**
The aggregate of competitions 4, 5,6 and 7.
10. **THE GRAND AGGREGATE**
The aggregate of Competitions 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6.
11. **CALEDONIAN SHIELD**
(Confined to National Members)
1st Stage:
Concurrent with competitions 3, 4 and 5.
Final Stage: Monday
Open to 15 competitors taking the highest places in the 1st Stage.
2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards.
The score in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score for the Faculty of Procurators Competition.
The places of all competitors in the Final Stage will be decided by the aggregate of their scores in the 1st and Final Stages.
12. **N. R. A. SILVER MEDAL**
The aggregate of Competitions 4, 5 and 600 metres shoot of Competition 1.
13. **SPECIAL "XX" MEDAL**
The aggregate of Competitions 1, 5 and 6.
14. **VETERANS**
Confined to competitors of 60 years of age and over.
Concurrent with the Scottish Championship 1st Stage.
15. **AUSTRALIA MEDAL**
Awarded to the highest placed Home Scot in the Grand Aggregate.

- 16. RIFLE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**
THE DARNLEY CHALLENGE PLATE
and four Bronze Medals of the Association.
- Entrance Fee: £4 per team.
Open to any number of teams of four from Rifle Clubs.
Entries with the names of teams to be made at Range Office
before 2.00 pm on Saturday.
Concurrent with 1st Stage of Scottish Championship.
- 17. SCHOOL AND UNIVERSITY CHALLENGE**
A SILVER CHALLENGE CUP
and four Bronze Medals of the Association.

Open to any number of teams of four individual students of any
School or University. Entries, with names of teams, to be made at
Range Office before 2.00 pm on Saturday.
Concurrent with 1st Stage of Scottish Championship.

Other as entries permit.

The Gold and Silver Medals will be awarded under the conditions stated in the programme.

SPECIAL PRIZES

- To encourage less experienced shooters, there will be special prizes in the following competition. Competitors eligible are those who are not Class "X" or "A"; are not eligible to shoot for the S. R. A. Gold Medal, but are National Members of the S. R. A. as at June 1, 2008.

GRAND AGGREGATE

- 1st: £15
- 2nd: £10
- 3rd: £5

In addition there will be a special Silver Thistle Badge for the highest school person.

CLASS "F" OPEN AND TR/F

- "F" Class Open and TR/F prizes will be awarded in the various competitions depending on number of entries.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND NOTICES

1. N. R. A. Regulations will govern the Meeting except where otherwise stated. Either 7.62mm or 5.56mm target rifles which comply with appropriate N. R. A. Regulations may be used. An 'F' Class Open and TR/F, is being continued this year. 'F' Class Open and TR/F rifles as defined by the N. R. A. for use in the 2008 Imperial Meeting may be used.
2. Any type of ammunition including handloads is permitted. Bullet weights (other than "F" Class) must be within the following limits; 7.62mm - not exceeding 155 grains, 5.56mm - no weight limit. The external dimensions of the case, as loaded and after firing, must not exceed the maximum dimensions shown on the current UK Government 7.62 x 51mm NATO or SAAMI 308 win chamber drawings. 7.62mm 155gn Sierra Palma ammunition will be available and can be ordered on the Entry Form. Surplus ammunition supplied by the Association **MUST** be returned.
3. Due to logistical circumstances we are unable this year to accommodate any firer whose firearm and ammunition combination produces muzzle energy above 4,500 joules.
4. Two sighting shots per distance in each Competition will be convertible.
5. V Bulls will be used throughout the competitions. The order of merit in all competitions will be decided by the number of V Bulls scored. Ties for first place will be shot off in The Grand Aggregate, Scottish Championship and Caledonian Shield otherwise placing will be decided by counting out. Cash prizes will be shared if they cannot be counted out.
6. The deposit fee to challenge the value of a signalled shot will be £1.
7. The Meeting Committee reserves the right to vary any matters connected with the Meeting.
8. N. R. A. classification for the current year shall apply.
9. Completed entry forms, together with entry fees, should reach the Meeting Secretary by 23rd May. Late entries will only be accepted if target accommodation permits and on payment of a 10% surcharge. All entries will be acknowledged by the issue of a **CAR PASS** for the Ranges.

Please **DISPLAY** this car pass on your **WINDSCREEN. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT. PLEASE CO-OPERATE.** Entrants will be advised if entries cannot be accepted.
10. Membership of the Association is a prerequisite for all competitions. Temporary membership for the period of the Meeting is £7.50.
11. Competitors will be squadded in either pairs or threes to a target this year.
12. Trophies may be won by any competitor (including honour only).
