Notes

Marking Electronic target marking will be used for this meeting. This is the first open meeting in Scotland to use electronic marking, so please be prepared for a few gremlins.

Squadding Competitors will be squadded two shooters to a target sharing one monitor.
Please give consideration to those requiring the right hand or left hand position in order for them to see the monitor and their scorebook.
Quick changeovers will be essential if we are to complete the shoot within a reasonable time. It will not be possible for the next two firers to get into position till the current firers are finished, so please clear the firing point immediately you finish your shoot. Please fill in as soon as your target is free, there will be only one detail at each distance.

Rifles (TR) Any target rifle conforming to NRA regulations in 7.62mm, 5.56mm or .303" calibre may be used. ('F' class rifles see under 'F' class.)

Ammunition Any ammunition including handloads may be used.
7.62mm R.G. Match with 155 grain bullets will be available, if required, this ammunition must be ordered on the entry form.
Surplus ammunition and empty cases bought from the Club must be returned.

Sighters	Sighters are convertible. All converted sighters from supplied ammunition must be returned.
Membership	Competitors must be paid up members of a Scottish Minister/Home Office approved club and/or holders of a current Firearms Certificate. All competitors must be members of the Club. Associate membership available for the period of the meeting is five pounds.
Conditions	N.R.A. Rules and Regulations will govern the Meeting except where otherwise stated.
‘F’ Class	<p>‘F’ Class is open to those competitors who wish to use rifles which do not conform to the standard definition of TR in NRA Rule 150.</p> <p>This class is open to rifles of any calibre up to 8mm falling within the limitations of calibre, velocity and muzzle energy specified in the Range Safety Certificate. (Max. muzzle velocity 3275 feet/sec, maximum muzzle energy 4500 joules)</p> <p>If a competitor is in any doubt that his rifle may not fall within the above limits, please check with John Potter (Phone No. 0141 644 3017) to ensure that their rifle complies.</p> <p>Rifles must comply with the NRA definition of an ‘F’ class rifle as specified in NRA rule 164. Summarised as follows:</p> <p>Bipods. A bipod or front rest is permitted to support the rifle or hand.</p> <p>Rear Rests: One or two sandbags may be used to support the butt. No mechanical rests are allowed.</p> <p>Muzzle Breaks: Prohibited.</p> <p>Rifle weight: Maximum weight 10kg.</p> <p>Pull of Trigger: The trigger pull must be not less than 0.5kg. unless the rifle is fully supported at front and rear in which case there is no limit. Where no minimum trigger pull weight is applicable the rifle must not fire when the bolt is cycled rapidly.</p> <p>Sights: Any, including magnifying or telescope.</p> <p>Position: Prone position shall be used at all distances.</p>
TR/F	Restricted to .308”/.223” calibres, a front rest or bi-pod is permitted together with a rear bag. Trigger pull weight 1.5kg as for TR.
Markers	No marking duties will be required, unless the electronic system fails and we have to resort to conventional methods. The aiming mark will have to be changed on each target when we move from 500 to 400 yards. (The order of shooting has been reversed to allow us to drop the 400 yard shoot should we run out of time.)
Challenges	In the event of a problem with the electronic marking system, please contact the assistant Range Conducting Officer.
Confined Championship	Open to fully paid up members of the Club. Concurrent with Competition No.4, the championship.
Trophies	<p>The Principal Trophies for TR are noted below. Additional TR trophies will be awarded together with trophies specifically for F Class competitions depending on number of entries.</p> <p>Championship – Open – The Ladies Cup Queen’s III – Open – The Col. Begg Trophy. Confined Championship – The Glasgow Herald Cup Confined Queen’s III – The Glasgow Evening News Cup</p> <p>The SRA Silver Medal will be awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate in Competitions Nos.2 and 3. (QII and QIII)</p> <p>All ties for trophies and SRA Silver Medal will be counted out.</p>
Prizes	There will be a cash prize list for each individual competition.
Location	The meeting will be held at Jubilee Range Blair Atholl.
