- 2. THE SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIP**
1st Stage:
Concurrent with competitions 3, 4 and 5
2nd Stage: Sunday
Open to 36 competitors taking the highest places in the 1st Stage. 2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards. The score in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score in the Royal Faculty of Procurators Competition.
Final Stage: Sunday
Open to 20 competitors (including "TR/F" Class depending on number of entries) taking the highest places in the 2nd stage, 2 sighters and 15 count at 1000 yards. The places of all competitors in the Final Stage will be decided by the aggregate of their scores in the 2nd and Final Stages. The score in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score in the City of Glasgow Competition.
- 3. STOCK EXCHANGE**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 400 yards.
- 4. BANNOCKBURN**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 500 yards.
- 5. PRESIDENTS**
2 sighters and 15 to count at 600 yards.

2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards.

2 sighters and 10 to count at 1000 yards.

(Confined to National Members)

1st Stage:

Concurrent with competitions 3, 4 and 5.

Final Stage: Sunday

Open to 15 competitors taking the highest places in the 1st Stage.

2 sighters and 15 to count at 900 yards.

The score in this shoot will also count as the competitor's score for the Faculty of Procurators Competition.

The places of all competitors in the Final Stage will be decided by the aggregate of their scores in the 1st and Final Stages.

12. N. R. A. SILVER MEDAL

The aggregate of Competitions 4, 5 and 600 yards shoot of Competition 1.

13. SPECIAL "XX" MEDAL

The aggregate of Competitions 1, 5 and 6.

14. VETERANS

Confined to competitors of 60 years of age and over.

Concurrent with the Scottish Championship 1st Stage.

15. AUSTRALIA MEDAL

Awarded to the highest placed Home Scot in the Grand Aggregate.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND NOTICES

1. N. R. A. Regulations will govern the Meeting except where otherwise stated. Either 7.62mm or 5.56mm target rifles which comply with appropriate N. R. A. Regulations may be used. A TR/F class is being continued this year. TR/F rifles as defined by the N. R. A. for use in the 2009 Imperial Meeting may be used.
2. Any type of ammunition including handloads is permitted. Bullet weights (other than "F" Class) must be within the following limits; 7.62mm - not exceeding 156 grains, 5.56mm - no weight limit. The external dimensions of the case, as loaded and after firing, must not exceed the maximum dimensions shown on the current UK Government 7.62 x 51mm NATO or SAAMI 308 win chamber drawings. 7.62mm 155gn Lapua ammunition will be available and can be ordered on the Entry Form. Surplus ammunition supplied by the Association MUST be returned.
3. Two sighting shots per distance in each Competition will be convertible.
4. V Bulls will be used throughout the competitions. The order of merit in all competitions will be decided by the number of V Bulls scored. Ties for first place will be shot off in The Grand Aggregate, Scottish Championship and Caledonian Shield otherwise placing will be decided by counting out. Cash prizes will be shared if they cannot be counted out.
5. The Meeting Committee reserves the right to vary any matters connected with the Meeting.
6. N. R. A. classification for the current year shall apply.
7. Completed entry forms, together with entry fees, should reach the Meeting Secretary by 22nd May. Late entries will only be accepted if target accommodation permits and on payment of a 10% surcharge.
8. Membership of the Association is a prerequisite for all competitions. Temporary membership for the period of the Meeting is £7.50.
9. Competitors will be squadded in pairs to a target this year.
10. Trophies may be won by any competitor (including honour only).
