Conditions of Shoot – SRA/NRA Rules – Electronic Target marking will be used throughout the meeting

Rifle Zero: It is important to minimize the chances of hitting a sensor that you have a known wind and elevation zero for each of the distances to be shot, especially the starting distance of 400yds.

PLEASE ADVISE THE RCO IF YOU DO NOT HAVE RELIABLE ZERO

Rifles & Ammunition – TR, F & TR/F Class rifles as defined in NRA Rules may be used. Any Ammunition including hand loads is permitted with the following limits on bullet weights: 7.62 not exceeding 155 grain & 5.56 not exceeding 90 grain. Handloaded ammunition must conform to the 4500 joules rule and confirmation is the responsibility of the firer. 7.62 Club ammunition will be available on the range for purchase, subject to prior notification and order on the ENTRY FORM. Surplus purchased ammunition and cases MUST be returned to the CLUB. Schools Issued ammunition may be used by Cadets.

Ties – For Trophies will be shot for – BUT ONLY IF V Bulls and count back are equal & time permits

Challenges – None Allowed. In the event of a problem with the electronic marking system Contact RCO

Schools / Students Entry

75% of full entry (rounded up) for persons in full time Education and under age 25 as at 1st March 2010.

Membership – Competitors MUST be paid up members of the CLUB, the SRA or any other Scottish Office or Home Office Approved Club holding a current licence. AS NOTED ON THEIR ENTRY FORM With their FAC Number.

Classes - TR Shooters will be classed 'A' or 'B' according to recent known form. If Classed 'B' a shooter may elect to shoot as Class 'A'

F Class will be in two Classes Open 'F' and TR/F as defined in NRA rules, (TR/F Locally amended rear bags allowed) There will be separate F Class and TR/F Class trophies and prizes, minimum of two entries.

'C' Schools & Juniors (under 25 years on 1st March 2010) 75% of full entry (rounded up)

'D' Ladies

'E' Seniors 75% of full entry (rounded up) for persons aged over 65 on the day of the shoot

NB If a shooter other than Class 'A' wins a principal Trophy the Class Prize for that Competition will go to the next highest placed shooter from that Class.

Squadding – Shooters will be squadded in pairs, sharing one monitor and shooting MUST START at 0930 hrs to ensure that we complete the programme. Please fill in as soon as your target becomes free, there will only be one detail at each distance. Requests for Later Shooting Order at 400m will be very restricted and reserved for those travelling long distances. ALL ESRC MEMBERS are required for duty or to shoot in the first Detail – UNLESS on other DUTY.

Assistance will be required with setting up and changing the targets after 400. If the weather is unkind we will also have to erect and shift the gazeboes at each distance.

NRA Rules 318 & 319 (the 45 second Rules) will apply to ensure programme is kept to time
