CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. NRA regulations will govern the Meeting except where otherwise stated.
2. 7.62mm or 5.56mm target rifles conforming to NRA TR specifications may be used. A diopter may be used if desired.
3. Two sighting shots per distance in each competition will be convertible.
4. Any type of ammunition including handloads is permitted. Bullet weights must be within the following limits:- 7.62mm – not exceeding 155 grains, 5.56mm – no weight limit. The external dimensions of the case, as loaded and after firing, must not exceed the maximum dimensions shown on the current UK Government 7.62 x 51 mm NATO or SAAMI 308 Win chamber drawings. 7.62mm 155gn Lapua Scenar ammunition will be available and can be ordered on the Entry Form. Surplus ammunition supplied by the Association **MUST** be returned.

5. Ties for first place in the Grand Aggregate (both TR and F Class) and Grand Masters Competition will be shot off. Otherwise placing in the various competitions will be decided by counting out.
6. The Meeting Committee reserves the right to vary any matter connected with the Meeting.
7. All TR competitors will shoot in one class.
8. An "F" Class Open and TR/F is being continued this year. "F" Class and TR/F rifles as defined in the 2009 NRA Bible with the exception that TR/F bullet weight is limited to a maximum of 156 grains and standard NRA long range targets will be used for TR/F. .
9. Membership of the Association is pre-requisite for all competitors. Temporary membership for the period of the meeting is £7.50.
10. All entries must be received by the Meeting Secretary no later than 22 May 2010. Late entries will only be accepted if target accommodation permits.

No receipts of acknowledgments will be issued unless specifically sought, but entrants will be advised if their entry cannot be accepted.

11. EARLY ENTRY DISCOUNT: In order to permit the meeting to be squadded, entries require to be received in advance of the meeting itself. Accordingly to encourage entries to be submitted promptly an early entry discount is offered.

GENERAL NOTES

1. *Trophies* – A trophy to be held by the winner for one year will be awarded for each competition. A SRA Silver Medal will be awarded to each of the winners of the Grand Aggregate TR Class, "F" Class Open and TR/F Class.
2. *Combined Grand Aggregate* – The "Long and Short" Trophy will be awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate from the Grand Aggregates in the "Scottish" Meeting and in the Long Range Championships.
3. *Family Pair Competition* – The "Penny" Trophy will be awarded to the highest aggregate made by two members of one family in the Long Range Championship Grand Aggregate. Entry for the Family Pair has to be notified to the Meeting Secretary by 11am 5 June 2010.
4. There will be a cash prize list on the Grand Aggregate only.
5. Sweepstake – There will be a Daily Sweepstake in which 75% of the entry monies will be returned.
6. Teams Match – Teams of four concurrent with the Sunday Aggregate. Entry on the Range before 9.15am on Sunday 6 June 2010 - £4 per team.
7. Dinner – Saturday 5 June 2010. It is proposed to hold an informal dinner on the Saturday evening in the Atholl Arms Hotel at a cost of £25 per person. All competitors and their partners are welcome to attend. Please indicate numbers who may attend the dinner on the entry form. Cash for the dinner will be collected on the day.
