

Glasgow 2014 Commonwealth Games Fullbore Target Rifle Events

As you will be aware, Glasgow is to host the XXth Commonwealth Games over the period 23 July to 3 August 2014. The Fullbore Target Rifle events, along with all events across the shooting disciplines, will be held at Barry Buddon, literally next door to the famous golf course at Carnoustie.

The Scottish Rifle Association, as a member organization of Scottish Target Shooting, is committed to providing technical advice, assistance and support for the target shooting events in the 2014 Games. In particular, this will include identification and training of volunteers as well as help with the provision of many of the technical officials required to stage the full bore rifle events.

Members of the Scottish Rifle Association, especially – though by no means exclusively - those with current Range Conducting Officer qualifications, are therefore now being sought to volunteer their expertise and thereby help ensure the success of the full bore rifle events. At this stage, with the Glasgow Organising Committee yet to appoint Cluster Event Managers and, ultimately, specific Sport Event Managers, it is not possible to provide exact details of the duties with which volunteers will be tasked nor of the full period of time over which their services might be required. Nevertheless, if you think you might be interested in being part of the volunteer team that will help run the 2014 full bore rifle competitions, please register your interest now with the Honorary Secretary of the SRA – an email will suffice - and thereby help the association get its preparations under way. In the meantime, further details will be provided as soon as they become known.
